This Indenture made this first day of October in the year of our Lord 1832 between Thomas B. Worrell of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Lewis Worrell of the same County and State of the other part witnesseth that the said Thomas B. Worrell for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand Dollars to him in hand paid by the said Lewis Worrell at or before the concluding delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained & sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto his son Lewis Worrell his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of Land situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of St. Lukes containing Estimating One hundred and Ninety acres be the same more or less it being a part of the same which said Party doth generally resile by going on the South side of the road leading from Clerk's Church Monroe and bounded as follows to begining on the Run of the Arthur Swamp whence said Run riseth in Jordan's line thence down the run of said Swamp the Run's course being to a corner for said Lewis Worrell's Crenshaw Land in Clerk's line thence along said Lewis Worrell's line of marker trees to the aforesaid land a new corner made on said Lewis Worrell's line thence along said Road or Crenshaw's Corner to the first station together with all rights title interest claims demands affward to the said tract or parcel of Land and premises with all houses outbuildings waters and water courses thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises as above described unto him the said Lewis Worrell his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only purpose and behoef of him the said Lewis Worrell and his heirs forever And the said Thomas B. Worrell for himself his heirs Executors administrators and assigns doth covenant and agree to and with the said Lewis Worrell his heirs Executors administrators and assigns that he will by these presents warrant and forswear the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises and every further and thereof against the claimants or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever in this behalf I the said Thomas B. Worrell have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the day and date first written
