 that the said Edmund Thorp and Mary his wife, John Thorp and Nancy his wife and Charity
 Thorp for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred dollars Current money of this Commonwealth
 to them in hand paid by the said Lewis Morrell at or before the making and delivery of these
 presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Have granted bargained sold aliened conveyed
 and confirmed and by these presents do and each of them doth grant bargain sell alien convey and
 confirm unto him the said Lewis Morrell his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of
 Land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke's Containing
 by Estimation One hundred and thirty two acres to the same more or less bounded as follows to wit Beginning
 at a dead pine standing near the Road in said Lewis Morrell's line as Corner Henry Jones's line along
 said Henry Jones's line of marked trees an Eastwardly Course to a white oak as Corner Doct. La Fayette Morris
 thence along his line of marked trees a North Eastwardly Course to a Black gum standing in said
 Morris's line as Corner for Benjamin Whitfield thence along said Whitfield's line of
 marked trees a Westwardly Course to the bend of the Deep branch thence up the Run of said branch
 to a gum standing near the Road as Corner for James Daughtry thence along said Daughtry's
 line of marked trees Westwardly Course to a lightwood post a Corner for said Lewis Morrell thence
 along said Morrell's line of marked trees a South Eastwardly Course to the first Station Together with
 all right title interest claim or demand of or in and to the above described tract or parcel of Land
 and premises with its appurtenances thence to belonging or in anywise appertaining to have
 and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises with all and singular its appur-
 tenances thence to belonging unto him the said Lewis Morrell his heirs and assigns forever and
 for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Lewis Morrell his heirs and assigns and
 the said Edmund Thorp and Mary his wife, John Thorp and Nancy his wife and
 Charity Thorp for themselves their heirs Executors and assigns do and each of them doth hereby
 Covenant and agree to and with the said Lewis Morrell his heirs Executors and assigns
 that they will by these presents warrant and forever defend the right and title of the above
 said tract or parcel of Land and premises and every part or parcel thereof against the claims or demands of persons
 every person or persons whatever with him or either of the said Edmund Thorp and Mary Thorp his wife
 John Thorp and Nancy Thorp his wife and Charity Thorp their heirs and assigns and
