and Conformed and by these presents do and each of them doth grant bargain sell alien and release
confirm unto him the said Lewis Morrell his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of
Land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of St. Luke's containing
of Estimation One hundred and sixteen acres to the Sides more or less and bounded all the way Beginning
at a dead pine standing near the Road on said Lewis Morrell's line & corner from Jones' line thence along
said Jones' line of marked trees an Eastwardly come to a large white oak on corner for Doct. La Fayette's line
thence along his line of marked trees a south Eastwardly come to a Black gum standing in said
Pompey's line a corner for Benjamin Whipple's line thence along back to Whipple's line of
marked trees a Northwardly come to the rear of the Doct. tract thence up the Run of said stream
to a gum standing near the Road a corner for James Daughtry thence along back Daughtry's
line of marked trees thence to a hickory post a corner for said Lewis Morrell thence
along said Morrell's line of marked trees a south Eastwardly come to the first stream thence upwards
all rights title interest claim or demand of me and to the above described tract or parcel of Land
and promises with its appurtenances thereunto belonging even any unapportioning thereof
and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises with all and singular its appur-
tenances thereunto belonging unto him the said Lewis Morrell his heirs and assigns forever to me
by the only just price we are beheld of him the said Lewis Morrell his heirs and assigns and

Covenant and agree to and with the said Lewis Morrell his heirs Executors etc and assigns
that they will by these presents warrant and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid
tract or parcel of land and premises and every part or part thereof, against the claims or demands of all
any person or persons whatever, both living or dead of whom the said Edmund Sharp and Mary Sharp his wife
Joshua Sharp and Nancy Sharp his wife and Charity Sharp have heretofore done or shall do
