This Indenture made this 16th day of March in the year of our Lords one thousand eight hundred and
thirty two Between Lewis Worrell of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and
Richard E. Worrell of the same County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Lewis
Worrell for and in consideration of the Sum of Three thousand dollars Current money to him in hand
paid by the said Richard E. Worrell at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and
by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto him the said Richard
E. Worrell his heirs and assigns forever One Certain Part or parcel of Land situate lying and
being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke's Containing by a recent
survey seven hundred and thirty acres be the same more or less including the Land formerly belong-
ing to Edmund and Joshua Thorp Robert Daughtry dec^d the Greenham plantation and part of
the Land formerly belonging Jacob Raulby dec^d and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at the corner
of the Arthur Swamp in the road leading from the High Ways to a house a corner of Thomas B. Worrell
