This Indenture made this 19th day of June in the year of our Lord Christ 1832. Between Simon Newell
Shaw (debt of the first part Allen Edward Trotter of the second part and Benjamin Griffin carrier
of the third part all of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia Whereas the said Simon Newell
Shaw as justly indebted to the said Benjamin Griffin in the sum of twenty dollars due by him
date with these presents which debt and interest the said Simon Broadbent is willing and desirous
to have at another Indenture W^t discharged shall for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid
for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to him without fee by the said Allen
Edward also before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
be the said Simon Broadbent hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents
do give grant bargained and sell unto the said Allen Edward his heirs and assigns for
the following property to wit One Cow and Calf One yearling three feathered hens and four
and Eight head of hogs with their future increase together with all and singular such
named property with all the right and title claim or demand in and to said property to have
and to hold the said hereby granted property unto the said ~~Allen Edward~~
Edwin Adams and assigns forever and the said Simon Broadbent for himself his heirs and assigns
doth hereby, covenant to and with the said Allen Edward his heirs and assigns the aforesaid
property hereby conveyed unto the said Allen Edward his heirs &c against all persons
whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend the same to him notwithstanding that the
said Allen Edward shall possess the said property Broadbent to remain in quiet and
peaceable possession of the above named property hereby conveyed and take the profit thereof
until default be made in the payment of the above sum of twenty dollars with the interest
accruing thereon either in the whole or in part and upon this further trust that he the said
Allen Edward his heirs Edwin Adams and assigns shall and will so soon after the happening
of such default of ~~Allen Edward~~ requested by the said Benjamin Griffin his heirs &c sell to the
highest bidder for ready money the property herein named after giving ten days notice of the time
and place of sale at as many public places in the neighborhood as he may think right
and the money arising from such sale first pay the charge of this Indenture and the debt
interest due to the said Benjamin Griffin his heirs &c and the overplus if any pay over to the said
Simon Broadbent or his representatives but of the above named sum of money and interest the same
be paid off at or before the happening of such default then this Indenture to be void and
remain in full force and virtue. In witness whereof the parties have hereunto set their
