This Indenture made this 21st day of March in year of our Lord 1832 Between Ridley Drake of the County of Southampton of the one part and James Ingers of the County aforesaid of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Ridley Drake for and in consideration of the good and just sum of five hundred and no dollars Current Money of Virginia to be paid by the said James Ingers to them and paid on the 23rd of July 1832 before the signing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Ridley Drake doth hereby acknowledge and therefore acquit and discharge the said James Ingers his heirs and assigns forever and themselves themselves fully and entirely satisfied contented and paid have granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien convey release and release unto him the said James Ingers and to his heirs and assigns forever all that plantation comprised tract and parcel of Land situate within the said James Ingers mens lands being the tract of land of Ridley Drake bounded lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and containing by estimation seventy five acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a corner tree a corner post made through bounded by a line of marked trees to a corner line of said Land on the branch which is a Poplar thence up the branch to a point where a line of marked trees to a point corner of Joshua Ingers line thence along a line of marked trees to a point corner of Ridley Drake thence along said line to a red oak a corner of Ridley Drake thence bounded by said said line to a point corner of said Land and thence a straight line to the beginning with all houses out houses edifices buildings woods ways water &c water courses profits hereditaments and appurtenances whatso ever to the same belonging or in any way appertaining and the revenues and revenues revenues and remainders and remainders profits and profits thereof and all the estate right title interest claims or demand of them the said Ridley Drake of in and to the same and way part thereof To have and to hold the said plantation tract or parcel of Land and premises aforesaid unto him the said James Ingers his heirs and assigns forever and the said Ridley Drake for themselves their heirs and assigns the said James Ingers and assigns the said seventy five acres of Land and premises as well all and singular the appurtenances aforesaid against him the said Ridley Drake and his heirs and assigns and against all persons who shall claim or demand the same or any part thereof shall and will ever and forever defend by these presents With Witness whereof the Ridley Drake have hereunto set their hand and affixed their seal this day and year first above written signed sealed and delivered in the presence of
