These Indentures made the 17<sup>th</sup> day of December in the 5<sup>th</sup> year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty one between Matthew Daughtery and Nancy his wife and Polly Daughtery the wife of Lemuel Daughtery all of the County of Stafford in the State of Virginia of the one part and Miles W Lawrence of the County of Stafford and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Matthew Daughtery and Nancy his wife and Polly Daughtery the wife of Lemuel Daughtery for and in Consideration of the sum of Six hundred and twenty five dollars to them in hand paid by the said Miles W Lawrence at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Matthew Daughtery and Nancy his wife and Polly Daughtery the wife of Lemuel Daughtery have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Miles W Lawrence his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Stafford containing by actual Survey Two hundred and ninety three acres and one fourth part to the same more or less bounded as follows. Beginning at a white oak standing near the road leading from South Spring to Jerusalem a corner of Samuel Gardner thence N. 41. N. 12 p. then N 57. N. 25 p. then N 107. N. 18 p. then N 2. N. 20 p. then N 21. N. 24 p. then N 54. 16 p. then N 12. E. 20 p. to a Cedar tree then along her line to a willow oak in Eggar Gull's line thence N 61. 10 p. then N 58. 66 p. to a red oak then N 65. N. 44 p. to a pine a corner of said John's line thence N 65. 20 p. to a white oak a corner of Meredith Hollands thence N 75. 87 p. to a corner of said Hollands thence N 6. N. 65 p. to a corner of said Hollands thence N 25. E. 25 p. to a maple a corner of Henry's line thence a curved line of marked trees N 30. N. 24 p. to a large pine thence N 5. N. 14 p. N 7. 10. 24 p. thence N 10. 6 p. thence N 20. N. 4. 0 p. then N 11. N. 23 p. to a gum thence N 5. N. 26 p. to a sand oak thence N 30. N. 22 p. to a red oak thence N 72. N. 28 p. to a pine a corner of Thomas Lawm's thence N 4. 2. 10. 6 p. to the first station together with all and singular the revenues and revenues, commons and commons, ways and diversities, profits and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the last tract or parcel of Land with the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Miles W Lawrence his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Matthew Daughtery and Nancy his wife and Polly Daughtery the wife of Lemuel Daughtery for themselves and their heirs the said tract or parcel of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights, moieties and appurtenances unto the said Miles W Lawrence his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claim of them the said Matthew Daughtery and Nancy his wife and Polly Daughtery the wife of Lemuel Daughtery or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every other persons or persons whatsoever shall or will and do in law and for ever defend by these presents.
