This Indenture made the 17th day of December in the Year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and
 thirty one Between Matthew Daughtery and Nancy his wife and Polly Daughtery, the wife of Lemuel Daughtery
 all of the County of Isle of Wight in the State of Virginia of the One part and Miles W. Lawrence of the
 County of Stafford and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Matthew Daughtery
 and Nancy his wife and Polly Daughtery the wife of Lemuel Daughtery for and in Consideration of
 the sum of Seven hundred and twenty five dollars to them in hand paid by the said Miles W. Lawrence of
 at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 by the said Matthew Daughtery and Nancy his wife and Polly Daughtery the wife of Lemuel
 Daughtery have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them do
 grant bargain and sell unto the said Miles W. Lawrence his heirs and assigns forever a certain
 tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Staffordshire containing by admea-
 suring Two hundred and twenty three and one fourth acres be the same more or less marked &
 bounded as follows. Beginning at a white oak standing near the road leading from Smiths Landing
 to Chancelors a corner of General Sanders thence N. 41. W. 12 p. thence S. 77. W. 28 p. thence N. 15 W.
 18 p. thence N. 2. W. 2 p. thence N. 31. W. 34 p. thence S. 57. W. 16 p. thence N. 12. E. 20 p. to a Red Cedar
 limb then along the line to a willow oak in Eggers Gull its line thence N. 12. E. 16 p. to a
 white oak thence N. 65. W. 44 p. to a pine a corner of said Sells thence S. 65. W. 20 p. to a white oak
 a corner of Merediths Hollands thence N. 70. E. 7 p. to a corner of said Hollands thence N. 65 p.
 to a corner of said Hollands line thence S. 25. E. 35 p. to a maple a corner of Chas. Percells then
 a new line of marked trees S. 35. W. 34 p. to a large pine thence S. 8. W. 14 p. N. 48. 24 p. thence S. 16 p.
 thence S. 12. 40 p. thence S. 41. W. 23 p. to a gum thence S. 55. W. 26 p. to a red oak thence N. 30. W. 32 p. to a red oak
 thence S. 72. W. 28 p. to a pine a corner of Thomas Lawrences thence S. 42. W. 5. 6 p. to the first station legible
 with all and singular the revenues and revenues hereditaries and hereditaries of any and otherwise
 issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract
 or parcel of Land with the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Miles W.
 Lawrence his heirs and assigns forever And the said Matthew Daughtery and Nancy his wife
 Polly Daughtery the wife of Lemuel Daughtery for themselves and their heirs the said tract or parcel
 of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned or intended to be
 bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights hereditaries and
 appurtenances unto the said Miles W. Lawrence his heirs and assigns free from the claims or claims
 of them the said Matthew Daughtery and Nancy his wife and Polly Daughtery the wife of
 Lemuel Daughtery or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every other person or persons
 whatsoever Shall ever and do warrant and forever defend by these presents. In Witness whereof

 aforesaid have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written
