This Indenture made this 3rd day of April in the year of our Lords 1832. Between Nathaniel Rechee of the first part, Luitton R. Edwards of the second part, and Stephen Mindaugh of the third part and all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, who as the said Nathaniel Rechee is hereby indebted to the said Stephen Mindaugh in the sum of Eight hundred and nine dollars and fifty cents to be paid on demand, bearing date the 3rd day of April 1832, also one other 1832 date April 2nd 1832, and pay all the 2nd day of December 1832, for one hundred and Eighty Dollars and seven Mills, the said Nathaniel Rechee being willing and desiring to secure the same, Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further Concinnation of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the said Nathaniel Rechee in hand paid by the said Luitton R. Edwards at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Nathaniel Rechee hath given, granted, sold, aliened, conveyed, released, confirmed and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain, sell, alien, convey, release and confirm to the said Luitton R. Edwards, his heirs and assigns for ever, all my lands, tenements of Southampton one tract of One hundred and twenty eight acres bounded by the lands of the heirs of Robert Williams and others and two hundred and Eighty two acres bounded by the lands of Elizabeth Mann, Adam Middleton, William Phillips and John at James also one tract containing one hundred and six acres bounded by the lands of Persons as is set out in the Clerk's Office, to the same more or less also the following Negroes to wit one negro named Sittin, one negro woman named Ann, and two others (the names of the children not recited and her future increase) one girl named Martha one negro man named Daniel and one negro man named Master, and all the estate right title and interest of the said Nathaniel Rechee in and to the said granted or intended to be hereby granted lands or parcels of Land and premises, To have and to hold the said hereby granted or intended to be hereby granted tracts of Land and premises with their appurtenances together with the appurtenances of the said Negroes and the future increase of the females thereof and all the other property hereby conveyed unto the said Luitton R. Edwards his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever to the use and behoof of the said Luitton R. Edwards his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever And the said Nathaniel Rechee for himself his heirs Executors and assigns doth promise and agree to and with the said Luitton R. Edwards his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever in manner and form following that is to say that the said Nathaniel Rechee his heirs Executors and administrators the aforesaid tracts or parcels of Land and premises with their appurtenances together with the aforesaid Negroes and the future increase of the females thereof unto the said Luitton R. Edwards his heirs Executors adm. and assigns forever against all persons who shall or will warrant and favor defend, by these presents, upon trusts, promises that the said Luitton R. Edwards his heirs Executors adm. and assigns shall from & after the said Nathaniel Rechee to remain quiet and peacefully possessors of the said tracts or parcels of Land and premises with its appurtenances together with the aforesaid Negroes and the future increase of the females thereof to his own use until default be made in the payment of the said debt or any of money either in the whole or in part and thereafter their further trusts that they or any two or either of them or the survivor of them or the heirs Executors adm. or assigns of either of them shall and will do soon after the happening of such default of payment as aforesaid either of them or the survivor of them or the heirs Executors adm. or assigns of either of them shall require or the said Stephen Mindaugh his Executors adm. or assigns shall require that the said tracts of Land and premises with the appurtenances together with the aforesaid Negroes and the increase of the females thereof hereby conveyed or deeded part of the hereby granted premises as the trustee or his representative hereby authorized to act shall think sufficient
