Esturson and William Esturson for and in consideration of the sum of twenty dollar Current money of Virginia the receipt whereof the said Simon Esturson and William Esturson doth acknowledge themselves fully and amply satisfied and paid, hath granted bargained sold conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Eliah Ellsworth one certain tract or parcel of land and premises situate and lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and on the South side of Hoffman's River and in St. Luke's Parish and bounded as follows: Beginning at a high ground post on said Ellsworth line thence along said Esturson line to high water post on a Branch thence up the said Branch or Eden's Creek line to a well on said Ellsworth line thence down said Ellsworth line to the first station containing more or less to the same more or less together with all that belongeth or in any wise appertaining to the said tract or parcel of land To have and to hold the same unto the said Eliah Ellsworth to him and his heirs forever and the said Simon Esturson and William Esturson for themselves their heirs Executors and assigns with these presents doth give warrant and defend all right titles claims or demands of any person or persons whatsoever to the said Eliah Ellsworth his heirs and assigns forever.
