Witnesseth that the said Simon Estusome and William Estusome for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and twenty five dollars of Virginia the receipt whereof the said Simon Estusome and William Estusome doth acknowledge themselves fully and completely satisfied and paid hath granted bargained sold alledged and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Job Ellsworth One Catoe back or parcel of land and premises situate and lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and on the Smith side of Cottenham River and in St. Luke's Parish and bounded as follows: Beginning at a lightning post in said Ellsworth line thence along said Cottenham line eight rods post in a Branch thence up the said Branch on either side line to a white oak in said Ellsworth line thence down said Ellsworth line to the first station containing moreover to the same monolith together with all that belongeth to or in any way appertaining to the said tract or parcel of land To have and to hold the same unto the said Job Ellsworth to him and his heirs forever and the said Simon Estusome and William Estusome for themselves their heirs Executors and assigns with their friends etc for ever manant and defend all right titles claim or demand from persons whatever to the said Job Ellsworth his heirs and assigns forever.
