This Indenture made and entered into on this 28th day of March 1832 Between Robert A Rogers and Lucy Rogers his wife of the one part and Edward Francis of the other part Testifies that for and in consideration of the sum of twenty dollars to them the said Robert A Rogers and Lucy Rogers wife in hand paid by the said Edward Francis at and before the making and delivery of these letters the full receipt of which is hereby acknowledged they the said Robert A Rogers and Lucy his wife have and lawfully bought and sold and by bargain and sale conveyed unto him the said Edward Francis his heirs and assigns forever all right title interest and estate in and to the following described lands or tenements lying in the County of Sandwich and bounded by the lands of the following named persons to wit on the North by Martha Smith on the East and North by Humphreys on the West by Perry's Lane and the purchase of the said Rogers widow and relict of Arthur Rogers deceased as her dower and more the wife of the purchaser to have and to hold the said lot and parcel of land described as aforesaid to him the said Edward Francis his heirs and assigns forever free from the claim of them the said Robert A Rogers and Lucy his wife or either of them their or either of them heirs and also free from the claim of all and every other person or persons whatsoever now or hereafter claiming and defend by these presents against all persons whomsoever the said land or lot of lands to him the said Edward Francis his heirs and assigns forever Well straight when of us and each of us have hereunto set our hands and seals the day and year herein first before written signed sealed acknowledged and delivered in presence of

This Indenture made this 12th day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty two Between Lucy Griffin of the one part and Joel Bradshaw of the other part Testifies that the said Lucy Griffin in consideration of the sum of thirty dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to her husband paid by the said Joel Bradshaw at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents have bargained and sold unto the said Joel Bradshaw his heirs and assigns my full right in the plantation formerly belonging to my husband William Griffin given to me during my natural life together with all the crops and houses, dove houses, barns, outbuildings, stables, yards, gardens, orchards and other immovables meadow, pastures
