 hold the said Lucy Griffin life together in the Plantation aforesaid and all her personal
 estate let it consist of what nature or kind soever it may be unto the heirs and assigns of
 her and her heirs the premises heretofore mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold of
 every part or parcel thereof with every of her right, moneys and appurtenances unto the said
 Broadhead his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said
 Broadhead his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Lucy Griffin for herself and her heirs the said
 Broadhead with and discharged the premises and appurtenances before mentioned the said
 Broadhead his heirs and assigns free from the claims of her the said Lucy Griffin her heirs and assigns
 every person or persons who shall ever shall and law warrant and force defend by these presents

This Indenture made this 7th day of April in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred
 and thirty two Between Sarah Ex parte of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and
 of the County of Madison and State of Alabama: Witnesseth that whereas the said Henry Geo
 Farris this day paid unto the said Sarah Ex parte the sum of four hundred and twenty nine dollars and
 cents being the amount of a Bond due to the said Sarah for the purchase of a certain negro slave
 named, Wides- and whereas at certain John McFarland has brought suit in the Superior Court
 of the County of Southampton and State of North Carolina against the said William H Geo to
 recover the said negro or the amount of his value and the said Sarah being willing and desirous
 and in only and in such manner the said Henry Geo from all recovery against him in the said Court
 at or for and in consideration of the promises the said Sally Geo bargain and sell with the
 Henry Geo the following negro slave named Martho May and Henry Geo in the
 conditions that if the said John McFarland shall recover of the said W H Geo in the said Court
 said aforesaid any damages costs or charges then it shall be lawful and the said Sally Geo
 willing that the said W H Geo shall after giving Two days notice sell at public sale the said
 slave aforesaid and out of the proceeds of such sale pay and satisfy his wife all such damages
 costs and charges as may be recovered against him in the said Court of law by the said John McFarland
