This Indenture made and entered into on the twentieth day of April in the year aforesaid one Thomas
 Eight hundred and thirty five. Between Joseph B. Whithead of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
 of the one part and Humphrey Drury of the same County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the
 said Joseph B. Whithead for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and twenty five dollars
 current money of the Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said Humphrey Drury all or
 before the enclosing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant
 bargain sell, alien enfeoff and confirm unto him the said Humphrey Drury his heirs and assigns
 forever One Certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being within the aforesaid County of
 Southampton and Parish of Saint Lukes containing by estimation One hundred and twenty acres be
 the same more or less it being a part of the Land that Nathaniel Whithead purchased of fifty
 Hughes and Pitman and was allotted to said Joseph B. Whithead by the Commissioners who were
 appointed to divide the Lands of John and Catherine Whithead dec'd and divided as follows to wit
 Beginning at a white and red oak corner for William B. Whithead in said Drury's line then
 along said W. B. Whithead's line of Marked Trees to Francis Kelley's line thence along
 line to the Kelley's Swamp thence up the run of said Swamp to said Humphrey Drury's
 thence along his line of Marked Trees to the Beginning. Together with all right title interest
 claim or demand of law and to the above described tract or parcel of Land and premises with
 its appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining. To have and to hold the
 aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises with all and singlular its appurtenances thence
 belonging unto him the said Humphrey Drury his heirs and assigns forever And the said
 Joseph B. Whithead for him self his heirs and assigns hath and doth hereby covenant warrant
 to and with the said Humphrey Drury his heirs and assigns and assigns that he will
 by these presents warrant and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract or
 parcel of Land and premises her by conveyed and conveyed unto him the said Humphrey Drury
 claim or demand of law and every other person or persons what soever. In Witness whereof
