 of lawful money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said Edward Drake at or before the making
 and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Have bargained and sold
 and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Edward Drake his heirs and assigns
 a certain tract or parcel of Land containing by the late Survey with the division of Joseph Drury's
 Land among the Legates fifty three acres being plot A. D. and bounded North by the Land of Mr. Samuel
 Drury's Land and on the East by Henry Briggs together with all the Lands herewith and thereon
 pertaining, woods, meadows, ways, water courses and privileges whatsover to the said Land belonging or
 appertaining, or with the same or any part thereof and the revenues and reversions remainder and
 remainders rents issues and profits thereof, and every part and parcel thereof. That he and he his
 the said tract or parcel of Land, with the hereditaments and all and singular when the premises
 herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof
 with every of the rights members and appurtenances unto the said Edward Drake his heirs and
 assigns forever to for the only use and behoof of him the said Edward Drake his heirs and
 assigns forever. And the said Hannibal Drury for himself and heirs his the said tract or parcel of
 Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said
 Edward Drake his heirs and assigns forever free from the claim or claims of him the said Hannibal
 Drury his or either of his heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall now and do
