

Each bargained and sold and by these presents doth give unto the said Abraham Reddick his heirs and assigns all the plantation tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton State of Virginia and more or less and also all the Soil, Mould, Wood, Waters, Advantages, Appurtenances, to the same or in anywise belonging and also the Right and Title of them the said Jacob C. Smith and to the same, To have and to hold the above granted and bargained premises with every of the appurtenances unto him the said Abraham Reddick his heirs and assigns In Fee Simple and it is hereby declared to be the true intent and meaning of these premises, that if the said Jacob C. Smith shall finally pay unto the said Benj^r Britte his heirs or assigns the said sum of Three hundred and Sixty five dollars, and thirteen Cents and interests accruable to the time of the said Britte's Land to the said Benj^r Britte then the said Abraham Reddick his heirs and assigns shall hold the said Land, to the sole and proper use and behoof of the said Jacob C. Smith and if the said Jacob C. Smith shall fail to pay the said Benj^r Britte the above mentioned sum and interest accruing thereon when demanded by the said Benj^r Britte then the said Abraham Reddick at the request of the said Benj^r Britte, shall advertise and sell the above described Tracts of Land for ready money after giving ten days previous notice of the time and place of sale and from the proceeds of said sale shall pay Benj^r Britte the amount of said Debt and all interest and Cost thereof accruing and the Surplus if any the said Abraham Reddick his heirs &c shall pay over to the said Jacob C. Smith his heirs Executors and assigns unto the said Jacob C. Sharp and Whereas the said Sum of money in said Deed mentioned having been fully paid unto the said Drummond, the said deed is void and of no effect, and the said Parties do hereby convey back the said Land unto the said John M. Archant and his heirs. Now this Indenture made this 10th day of March 1832 between the said W. H. Sharp and W. J. Foster of the one part and the heirs of the said John M. Archant of the other part, he the said John M. Archant departed this life and the execution of the said Deed of Trust W. H. Sharp and W. J. Foster for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to the said W. H. Sharp and W. J. Foster as aforesaid and of the further consideration of the payment of the said Debt
