This Indenture made the fourth day of April 1832 Between Benjamin Simmons of the first part Thomas Simmon of the second part and Alice B. Nicholson of the third part Whereas the said Benjamin Simmons is greatly indebted to the said Alice B. Nicholson on the sum of two hundred and thirty five dollars and thirty cents due by her bearing date unto the presents and the said Benjamin Simmons being willing and desirous to discharge the payment of the aforesaid sum of \$234. 30cts. Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Benjamin Simmons for and in consideration of the promises aforesaid as also the further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Simmon hath bought and sold and by these presents doth buy and sell unto the said Thomas Simmon One tract of land lying and being in the County of Southampton bounded as follow namely Daniel W. Simmon South by the land of Amos Drake formerly owned by Daniel W. Simmon. South by the land of Amos Drake formerly owned by Daniel W. Simmon his heirs and assigns forever upon trust nevertheless that is the said Benjamin Simmons shall pay and satisfy the debt aforesaid due to the said Alice B. Nicholson with the interest that may have accrued thereon on or before the 1st day of April next then the aforesaid lands shall be released but in default of payment this being made it shall be the duty of the said Thomas Simmon to advertise the time and place of sale and to proceed to sell to the highest bidder the said tract of land for cash and out of the proceeds of such sale pay the debt of \$234. 30cts with the interest to the said Alice B. Nicholson and the costs of the trust and the balance pay to the said Benjamin Simmons his heirs or assigns.
