This Indenture made and entered into on this third day of April in the year of our Lord
1832 one thousand eight hundred and thirty two: Between Edmund Thorpe of the County of Southampton
and State of Virginia Trustee to a certain Deed of Trust executed by John Whitfield for certain
purposes therein mentioned bearing date on the 20th day of June 1831 and duly Recorded in
the Clerk's Office of the aforesaid County of Southampton of the one part and Richard Jordan of the
same County and State of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Edmund Thorpe Trustee
by us, each of the Creditors mentioned in the said Deed of Trust did on the third day of
April last after giving public notice of the time and place of sale as was required by the
said Deed of Trust, sell the tract or parcel of land and premises therein conveyed by said
John Whitfield to the highest bidder, and Richard Jordan became the purchaser for the
sum of Three hundred dollars. Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said
Edmund Thorpe Trustee for and in consideration of the said sum of Three hundred dollars can with many
of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said Richard Jordan at or before the recording
and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, conveyed
sold, aliened, enfeoffed and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant, convey, sell, alien, enfeoff
and confirm unto him the said Richard Jordan his heirs and assigns forever, all the said
tract or parcel of land and premises conveyed in said Deed of Trust by John Whitfield to the
aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of St. Lukes containing by late Survey
