This Indenture made the 29th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand
 Eight hundred and thirty: Between Lemuel Daugherty of the one part, and Aaron Holland of
 the other part both of the County of Southampton and the State of Virginia: Witnesseth
 that on a deed of trust executed by the said Aaron Holland on the 9th day of September
 1829, and of Record in the Clerk's Office of said County, by the said Aaron Holland conveyed
 to the said Lemuel Daugherty as Executor, trustee or power of attorney and being within the
 County of Southampton, adjoining the Lands of Thomas Gardner John J. Hopson others containing
 One hundred acres more or less as trustee for Sipsa Parker in order to secure the payment of
 certain debt due said Parker and as the aforesaid Debt with lawful interest thereon
 has been of late fully paid off and discharged by the said Aaron Holland and conse-
 quently the said deed of trust being void and of no effect This Indenture therefore
 further witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and also for the
 further consideration of one dollar to him the said Lemuel Daugherty in hand paid
