and Sally his wife both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and in the
Hart Parish of St. Luke of the one part and John Hart of the same County and Elizabethtown
of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Edwin G. Hart and Sally his wife for and
in Consideration of the sum of Elizabethtown, and twenty dollars Current money of Virginia
to him in hand paid by the said John Hart, her husband and old account off and
confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said John Hart his
husband aforesaid forever, One certain Trail or path of Land Situate lying and being
in the County State and Parish aforesaid containing by a late Survey two hundred and
Sixty acres and One half bounded as follows Beginning at a post standing in the
State line a new corner made between Edwin G. Hart and the said John Hart
thence along the State line due East 300 poles to a post a corner of Settled Land
thence N 14 E 22 poles thence N 8 W 60 poles on the Virginia line thence due North
196 poles to a Hickory a new corner made between Edwin G. Hart and John Hart
Standing near the side of the road thence along said road N 6 E W 100 poles to a small
tree oak bush a new corner made by Edwin G. Hart and the said John Hart thence
S 11 E W 40 poles more or less bounds thence along the run of said branch to the first
Station thereon S 14 E W 60 poles from the branch to the beginning together with all the
houses and houses, gardens or orchards, ways, waters, and all franchises whatsoever belonging
