 of the other part. Witnesses that the said Edwin G. Hart and Sally his wife for and
 in consideration of the sum of Eleven hundred and twenty dollars Current money of Virginia
 to him hereunto paid by the said John Hart, here bargained sold aliened enfeoffed
 confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said John Hart his
 heirs and assigns forever, One certain tract or parcel of Land Situate lying and being
 in the County State and Parish aforesaid containing by a late survey two hundred and
 sixty acres and one half bounded as follows Beginning at a spring standing on the
 State line a new Corner made between Edwin G. Hart and the said John Hart
 thence along the State line due East 250 poles to a spring a corner of Jesse Gardner
 thence N. 42. E. 22 poles thence S. 41. 60 poles on the Virginia line thence due North
 156 poles to a Hickory a new corner made between Edwin G. Hart and John Hart
 standing near the side of the road thence along said road S. 6. 11. 180 poles to a small
