 the East by Richard Stevens formerly Mollis Land on the North by Edwin Miller
 Land and on the West by Drury Waller Land and the Land of William Herring
 all together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in
 any wise appertaining to have and to hold the said tract of Land with all
 and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining from
 us the said Arthur T Foster and wife unto the said Atacham Pope his heirs and assigns
 forever. And the right and title to which said tract of Land we the said Arthur
 T Foster and wife distinctly convey and give in award and of free unto the said Atacham
