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This Indenture made this 29th day of March A.D. one thousand Eight hundred and thirty between Arthur T Foster and wife of the one part and at Ashm Pope of the other part witnesses etc. that for and in consideration of the sum of Six hundred dollars paid to the said Ashm Pope the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged I have bargained and sold and by these presents do hereby and sell to the said Ashm Pope a certain tract of land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing four hundred and fifty acres more or less and bounded as follows on the South by Barron's road on the East by Richard Hurwitz formerly Miller's Land on the North by Edwin Waller's Land and on the West by Drury Waller's Land and the Land of William Williams dec^d together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining To Have and to hold the said tract of Land with all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging or in any way appertaining from us the said Arthur T Foster and wife unto the said Ashm Pope his heirs or assigns forever. And the right and title to which said tract of Land we the said Arthur T Foster and wife do hereby convey and forever warrant and defend unto the said Ashm Pope his heirs or assigns forever And I do hereby witness that we have hereunto set our hands and seals this day and date afore written -
