Mahone at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents doth acknowledge her hereby acknowledged her having granted bargained and sold and by these presents to the receipt whereof she hereby acknowledges her having granted bargained and sold and by these presents to the receipt whereof she grants bargains and sells alien enforfe and Conferm unto him the said Fulting S. Mahone his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of Land situated lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia containing intituled One half acre the same more or less it being a part of the land which was laid off into lots by Clements Rockelle in establishing the town of Monroe and being of the land lot as was purchased by said Thomas M. Gillet of the said Clements Rockelle aforesaid which will fully appear by referencing had to the record in the Clerks Office for the County and of said Land from said Clements Rockelle to said Thomas M. Gillet and now bounded all around by the lands of the said Fulting S. Mahone together with all right title interest claim or demand of in and to the said tract of Land and premises with its appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise pertaining to have and to hold the same described tract or parcel of Land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said Fulting S. Mahone his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only purpose and behoof of him the said Fulting S. Mahone and his heirs and the said Thomas M. Gillet for himself his heirs Executors administrators and assigns freely these presents covenant and agree he and with the said Fulting S. Mahone his heirs Executors administrators and assigns that they will furnish him after by these presents warrant and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract of Land and premises with its appurtenances against the claim or demand of all and every person or persons whatsoever.
