This Indenture made and entered into this 21st day of July one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine Between Thomas M. Gillet of the first part and Filding McMahon of the second part. Witnesseth that the said Thomas M. Gillet for and in consideration of the sum of Ten thousand Dollars (\$10,000) of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Filding McMahon at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents lets grant bargained and sell along with and confirmed unto him the said Filding McMahon his heirs and assigns forever One Certain Tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia containing situate and One half acre or the same more or less it being a part of the lands which was laid off into lots by Clements Rochelle in establishing the town of Henry and being the said lot as was purchased by said Thomas M. Gillet of the said Clements Rochelle and which will fully appear by reference being had to the record in the Clerk's Office for the County and of said Land from said Clements Rochelle to said Thomas M. Gillet and now bounded all around by the lands of the said Filding McMahon together with all right title interest claim or demand of law and to the said Tract of Land and premises with its appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining To have and to hold the same described Tract or parcel of Land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said Filding McMahon his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Filding McMahon and his heirs and the said Thomas M. Gillet for him self his heirs Executors administrators and assigns doeth by these presents Covenant and agree to and with the said Filding McMahon his heirs Executors administrators and assigns that they will forever hereafter by these presents warrant and forever defend the right and title of the above said Tract of Land and premises with its appurtenances against the claims or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever.
