This Indenture made this 21st day of May in the year 1832 Between M^{rs} Bridget
Wife of the first part Simon & Murfee Executors of the first part and Eli & J^r Mahone
of the third part: Witnesseth that whereas the said Feilding & Mahone by this Indenture
of first recited to the said P^rsonas for the benefit of said M^{rs} Murfee which deeds is duly recorded
in Clerk's Office of Southampton County bearing date the 24th day of October 1823. Conveying
therein a certain tract of Land near Monroe to secure to said M^{rs} Murfee the amount of three
several Obligations amounting each to the sum of \$166.66 &c. each payable on the 25th Decr. 1824.
5 & 6. and the said Mahone having fully paid and discharged the aforesaid several
Bonds together with the interest thereon and all costs attending the same acquiesced of said
P^rsonas and M^{rs} Murfee a release of said tract of Land which they are willing to do.
Now this Indenture further Witnesseth that the said P^rsonas and M^{rs} Murfee
for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid as well for and in consideration
of the sum of One dollar to them in paid by the said Mahone the receipt whereof
they do hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained sold conveyed released and confirmed
and by these presents doth grant bargain sell convey release and confirm
unto the said Feilding & Mahone his heirs &c. forever the aforesaid tract of
Land near Monroe. To have and to hold the said tract of Land to him the
said Mahone and his heirs against the claim or claims after the said M^{rs} P^rsonas
and Simon & Murfee or either of us or either of them &c. In Testimony whereof

Riddick of Guilford County North Carolina of the third part Witnesseth that
whereas the said Samuel Williams is justly indebted to the said Abraham Riddick
in the sum of four hundred Dollars as well known fully appear by his bond executed
to the said Abraham Riddick and bearing date on the same date with this inden-
ture which said sum of four hundred dollars he the said Samuel Williams is
willing and desirous to secure. Now therefore for and in consideration of the premises
and for the further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said
William Harrison the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said
Samuel Williams has granted bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents
doth grant bargain sell and convey to the said William Harrison his heirs &c.
a negro the following negro slaves now Tom, Phillis and Cate and the heirs
in case of the said Phillis and Cate To have and to hold the said negroes
and their increase to him the said William Harrison his heirs and assigns
forever Upon this Special Grant and Condition Notwithstanding that the said
