of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged both granted bargained and
sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto and confirm unto the said
Fuldin S. Mahone his heirs and assigns forever one third part of an undivided
tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
in an Acre or more near the town of Accomack and containing by estimation in the
whole tract three hundred and Eighty acres be the same more or less all of which were
undivided and at large as prior by reference from the deed from Henry H. Hays
to the said Fuldin S. Mahone in being the said one third part of the said undivided
tract of Land which was conveyed by the said Henry H. Hays to the said Fuldin
S. Mahone in the year Eighteen hundred and twenty seven and which is now on
record in the Clerk's Office of the aforesaid County of Southampton. Together with
all right title interest claim or demand of or unto the said one third part of the aforesaid
undivided tract of Land and premises with its appurtenances thereto belonging
or in any wise appertaining To have and to hold the above described one third
of the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises with all and singular appurtenan-
ces thereto belonging unto him the said La Fayette Broom his heirs and assigns forever.

And for the only proper use and behoof of him the said La Fayette Broom and his
heirs And the said Fuldin S. Mahone for him self his heirs & assigns by these pres-
ents Covenant and agree to and with the said La Fayette Broom his heirs & assigns
and assigns that he will forever hereafter by this presents Covenant &
define the right and title of the aforesaid one third part of the aforesaid described
tract or parcel of Land and premises with its appurtenances against the claim
or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever In witness whereof the
said Fuldin S. Mahone and Marshall his wife hath hereunto set their hands
