This Indenture made and entered into this 24th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty two between Fulding S. Mahone and Martha his wife of the one part and Lafayette Brown of the other part, both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Fulding S. Mahone and Martha his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand four hundred and fifty dollars current money of the State of Virginia to him the said Fulding S. Mahone in hand paid by the said Lafayette Brown at or before the execution and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Lafayette Brown his heirs and assigns forever One Certain tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the aforesaid County and State as follows to wit: Beginning at a right point at the Old road (at the head of Cassard's Street thence along the said Street South 13 East 40 poles to a Sasaparilla Stake thence across a deep ditch thence North 89 East 20 poles to a hickory wood Stake by the Side of a Stone corner of Wells Messrs' Lot and thence South 13 East 58 3/4 poles to a Sasaparilla Stake in a ditch a line between a tract of land called the Hodges land and the former thence along the said line with the Hodges land which is an undivided tract of land between Fulding S. Mahone and William Hodges of which Fulding S. Mahone owns two thirds and Hodges one third, to the land of Wells and Allen's Estate thence along the said line across the road to a Maple a corner of the said Allen's Estate and the premises herein conveyed thence along said Brown's land to the Beginning - All of which will more fully appear by reference to a plat of said premises and map to the said Fulding S. Mahone it being the same tract or parcel of land as was conveyed by said Thomas Messrs and wife to the said Fulding S. Mahone and his heirs forever except a lot called Gilet's containing one half acre the boundaries and description of which will be seen (reference being had to a deed from to Mr. Gilet also one and a half acres consisting of three half acres late belonging to the said Messrs and his heirs and the said F. S. Mahone was made and signed the title of the said deed to him the said F. S. Mahone and his heirs against the claim of himself and his heirs and against the lawful claim of all others. Witnesseth whereof the said Fulding S. Mahone and Martha his wife have herunto set their hands and seals the date above written.
