 thousand eight hundred and thirty five between Fulding Mahone and Marthas his wife of the one
 part and Lafayette Brown of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part all
 that the said Fulding Mahone and Marthas his wife for and in consideration of a certain sum of
 Sum of Two Dollars Current money of the State of Virginia to him without paid together with
 Lafayette Brown at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted bargained and sold and by these
 presents doth grant bargain and sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto him the said
 Lafayette Brown his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or lot of land
 situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton containing by estimate
 five one half acres the same more or less it being a part of the land which was laid
 off into lots in the town of Kennebec being the same lot as was conveyed by Brown
 Sell to the said Fulding Mahone which will appear on Record in the Clerk's Office
 of the aforesaid County of Southampton together with all other rights title interest claims
 or demands of in and to the said tract or lot of land and premises with its appurtenances
 named therein belonging or in any wise appertaining To have and to hold the said
