That Indenture made and entered into the 21st day of May in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and thirty five, between Fulding McMahon and Martha his wife of the one
 part and Lafayette Brown of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnessed
 that the said Fulding McMahon and Martha his wife for and in consideration of the sum of
 Ten Dollars Current money of the State of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said
 Lafayette Brown at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted bargained and sold and by these
 presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Lafayette Brown his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or lot of land
 situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton containing by estimate
 five one half acres the same more or less it being a part of the land which was laid
 off into lots in the town of Kennebec being the same lot as was conveyed by Brown
 to the said Fulding McMahon which was appraised on Record in the Clerk's Office
 of the aforesaid County of Southampton together with all other rights interests claims
 or demands of in and to the said tract or lot of land and premises with its appurtenances
 manes, thereto belonging or in any way appertaining To have and to hold the said
 descent Lot of Land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances then to
 belong unto him the said Lafayette Brown his heirs and assigns forever
 to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Lafayette Brown and
 his heirs and the said Fulding McMahon his heirs of his heirs Executors Administrators
 and assigns doth by these presents Covenant and agree to and with the said Lafayette
