 thousand Eight hundred and thirty two. Between Joseph T. Cloud and Elizabeth his wife
 of the first part and John Drury of the second part all of the County of Southampton and
 State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Joseph T. Cloud and Elizabeth his wife in
 consideration of the sum of Three hundred dollars of lawful money of Virginia to them in hand
 paid by the said John Drury at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do
 bargain and sell unto the said John Drury his heirs and assigns all our right title
 and interest in and to a certain tract or parcel of land situated and lying in the
 County of Southampton and State of Virginia and known as of Mount Lebanon
 at a holly tree in the said John Drury's line on the road leading from Belvidere to
 Cornwall. thence up the said Road to the fork leading to the Crop Ridge by Hampton
 Drury's thence down the said Road to a post oak in the said John Drury's line
 to the beginning it being a part of the tract of land bequeathed to Joseph T. Cloud
 by the last will and Testament of Jesse M. Cloud who is the vendor hereof and
 during his natural life or so long as he is and lying and being in an angle of five rods
 before the said John Drury's door containing or supposed to be sixty acres & the same
 more or less To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the tenements
 hereditaments and all and singular the premises therein before mentioned or intended
