Eight hundred and thirty two Between Joseph T Claude and Elizabeth his wife  
Drawy of the first part and John Drawy of the second part all of the County of Southampton and  
State of Virginia. Whereas it is agreed between the said Joseph T Claude and Elizabeth his wife on  
consideration of the sum of Three hundred dollars of lawful money of Virginia to them in hand  
paid by the said John Drawy at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the  
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents let  
bargain and sell unto the said John Drawy his heirs and assigns all our right title  
and interest in and to a certain tract or parcel of land situated and lying in the  
County of Southampton and State of Virginia and bounded on the west by a line beginning  
at a beech tree in the said John Drawy's line on the road leading from Belfield to  
Jerusalem, thence up the said Road to the fork leading to the Crop Field by Hambly  
Drawy thence down the said road to a post oak in the said John Drawy's line  
to the big running of bunge part of the tract of land bequeathed to Joseph Claude  
by the last will and Testament of wife Abigail which the widow before and  
during her natural life or widowhood and by my and being on an angle of meadow  
before the said John Drawy's door containing as supposed to be forty acres in the same  
more or less To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the former 3  
hereditaments one all and singular the premises herein before mentioned or contained
