Witnesseth that the said Mary Rice in consideration of the sum of Forty dollars to her in hand paid by Allen Rice at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby attested have bargained and sold and to pass presents do bargain and sell unto the said Allen Rice his heirs and assigns on their part of my right in the down land that was allotted to Polly Rice widow of said Rice dec^d together with all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging To have and to hold the said right title or interest of Land above mentioned or to be bargained and sold unto the said Allen Rice his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Allen Rice his heirs and assigns forever And the said Mary Rice for herself and her heirs the said right a parcel of Land with all and singular the appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Allen Rice his heirs and assigns free from the claim of them the said Mary Rice her heirs and of all and every persons or persons whatsoever should well and to warrant and forever defend by these presents In Witness whereof the said Mary Rice have hereunto set her hands and seal the day and year first above written
