Sell unto the said Joseph T. Olard his heirs and assigns all my right title and  
interest in and to a certain tract or parcel of land situated and lying in the County  
of Southampton and State of Virginia and known by the name of the willerfield  
Containing One hundred and . acres to the same more or less and bounded by the same  
as follows to wit by the road leading from Bullfield to Jerusalem on the south and William  
Jones on the South and Joseph Glanton on the West and David Westbrook on the East  
To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land together with all and singular  
the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold unto the  
Joseph T. Olard his heirs and assigns forever from the claim of John the  
Nancy Holt and every other person or persons claiming under her in any manner  
what ever shall and will and do warrant and forward defend by these presents he  
wishes which of the said Nancy Holt have herunto set her hand and seal
