hundred dollars of lawful money of Virginia to her in hand paid by the said Joseph
T. Claird at or before the sealing hereof delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
whereby she acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and
sell unto the said Joseph T. Claird his heirs and assigns all my right title and
interest in and to a certain tract or parcel of land situated and lying in the County
of Southampton and State of Virginia and known by the name of the wellford tract
Containing One hundred and acres be the same more or less and bounded by the line
as follows to wit by the road leading from Bellfield to Jerusalem on the north and William
Jones' on the south and Joseph Clanton on the West and David Westcott on the East
To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land together with all and singular
the premises hereunto in anywise mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold unto the
said Joseph T. Claird his heirs and assigns forever from the claim of her the said
Mary Holt and every other person or persons claiming or to claim hereunto
whatsoever shall will and do even unto and for ever defend by these presents in
