This Indenture made this 10th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and thirty one Between James B. Weymouth of the first part, Benjamin Weston and
Polly his wife of the second part and John Weymouth of the third part: Whereas the said
Benjamin Weston and Polly his wife on the 20th day of October 1828 in & to wit: Claim the
payment of the sum of forty dollars and 79 cts. to the said John Weymouth and to give in
the time of first of that date conveyed to the said James B. Weymouth his heirs Executors &c
the interest to which the said Weston and his wife are in the said John Weymouth
dower upon trust for the uses and purposes in the said indenture mentioned and to have
signed the indenture and delivery of the said deed of first the said Benjamin Weston
and his wife jointly fully satisfied and paid to the said John Weymouth the several sums
of money thereby secured to which the said John Weymouth do hereby acknowledge that
This Indenture witnesses that for the consideration aforesaid, as well as for the further
consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said Benjamin Weston and Polly his wife to the said
James B. Weymouth at and before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged by the said James B. Weymouth as with the assent and approbation of
the said John Weymouth signified by his being party to these presents, and the said
John Weymouth have granted, conveyed and sold promised released and confirmed and by
these presents do grant, convey and sell remise release and confirm unto the said Benjamin
Weston and his wife all the right title interest claim and demand both at law and in
equity to which the said James B. Weymouth and John Weymouth have or hold in the land
above described. To have and to hold the said land tract or parcels of land to the said Benjamin
Weston and wife their heirs Executors admors and assigns forever to the only proper use and
 beho of of them the said Benjamin Weston and wife their heirs Executors admors and assigns forever
and the said James B. Weymouth and John Weymouth for themselves their heirs Executors
administrators the above mentioned land unto the said Benjamin Weston and wife
their heirs Executors admors and assigns in as full and ample manner as the same was
 warranted by the said Benjamin Weston and wife by the deed of first above recited do
 warrant the same to the said Benjamin Weston and wife against the claim or claims of
 them the said James B. Weymouth and John Weymouth and all persons claiming by
