Know all men by these presents that J. Robert B. Moby of the County and State aforesaid for and in our own name and consideration we herewith moving have made authorize, nominated and appointed, and by these presents do make authorize, nomination and lawful attorney for me and in my name, and for my own proper and undoubted use and behoof, either of public or private, sale all my interest claim right or title in and to a certain tract of Land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia perfect title to the same to make, seal, and deliver. And furthermore I do hereby title and approve how the said J. Moby my Attorney as aforesaid to ask for demand, receive and recover of and from any person or persons in the State of Virginia all sum or sums of money or other thing whatsoever which is due and owing to me from any person or persons in the said State and he is hereby authorized to commence and in my name to prosecute any and all suits, debts and accounts or other sufficient demands for the same for me and in my name to make seal and deliver as aforesaid and to do all other lawful acts and things whatsoever becoming the premises aforesaid as fully and perfectly in every respect as I myself might or could do were I personally present at the doing thereof making and conforming and by these presents allowing whatsoever my said Attorney shall in my name lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents.
