This Indenture made this 23rd day of January 1833 Between Gilbert H. Brule of Southampton County of the first part and William B. Whithead of the town of Suffolk of the second part and all the Specially and Simple Contract Creditors of the said Gilbert H. Brule of the third part. Whereas the said Gilbert H. Brule is greatly indebted to divers persons and being desirous affinately to have the payment of the same fully as welling to carry and aforesaid purpose that purpse to the said William B. Whithead all his the said Paul's Stock of goods and merchandize together with his debts due by bond note or account aforesaid Inventory and Schedule annexed. This Indenture therefore doth witness that the said Gilbert H. Brule for and in Consideration of the premises and also the sum of one dollar paid in hand paid by the said William B. Whithead before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold alienated, fine and assigned, and by these presents doth grant bargain sell, transfer and assign unto the said William B. Whithead his heirs Executors and Administrators all the said Stock of goods and merchandize together with the debts aforesaid. To have and to hold the said Stock of goods and Merchandize together with the aforesaid debts unto the said William B. Whithead his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever. In trust nevertheless that he the said William B. Whithead shall sell and dispose of the said Stock of goods and Merchandise in such manner as to him shall seeme fit and shall have full power and authority to receive and collect by suit or otherwise the debts aforesaid and out of the monies arising from the sale and collecting aforesaid after deducting the necessary expenses of the same pay and satisfy the claims and demands due to the Creditors of the said Gilbert H. Brule then and there alike upon the condition of obtaining for the said Gilbert H. Brule a clear and absolute discharge and release for and on account of all presenting debts or demands. And the said William B. Whithead for himself his Executors and Administrators covenants with the other party to this instrument that he will faithfully execute the trust hereby reposed in him and apply the proceeds of such sale and collection according to the true intent and meaning of this deed and whatever balance of money arising from the said sale and collection shall remain after satisfying and paying the debts due to the Creditors of the said Gilbert H. Brule shall be returned to him the said Gilbert H. Brule or his proper representative. In witness whereof the said Gilbert H. Brule and William B.
