The Indenture made this 23rd day of January 1833. Between Gilbert H. Beale of
 Southampton County of the first part and William B. Whitehead of the town of Suffolk of the
 second part and all the specially and simply Contract Creditors of the said Gilbert H. Beale
 of the third part. Whereas the said Gilbert H. Beale is partly indebted to divers persons
 and being desirous effectually to secure the payment of the said debts is willing to convey
 and assign over to the said William B. Whitehead all his the said Beale's
 stock of goods and merchandize together with his debts due by bond note or account as for
 Inventory and Schedule annexed. This Indenture therefore Witnesseth that the said Gil-
 bert H. Beale for and in Consideration of the premises and also the sum of one dollar then
 in hand paid by the said William B. Whitehead before the sealing and delivery of these
 presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged doth grant bargain sell trans-
 fer and assign, and by these presents doth grant bargain sell transfer and assign
 unto the said William B. Whitehead his heirs Executors and administrators all the said
 stock of goods and merchandize together with the debts aforesaid. To have and to hold
 the said stock of goods and Merchandize together with the aforesaid debts unto the said
 William B. Whitehead his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever. In witness
 whereof that he the said William B. Whitehead shall sell and dispose of the
 said stock of goods and Merchandize in such manner as to him shall seem right &
 shall have full power and authority to receive and collect by suit or otherwise the debt
 aforesaid and out of the monies arising from the sales and Collection aforesaid after
 deducting the necessary expenses of the said pay and satisfaction by the claims and demands
 due to the Creditors of the said Gilbert H. Beale there and there alike upon the condi-
 tion of obtaining for the said Gilbert H. Beale a clear and absolute discharge and release
 for and on account of all present debts or demands And the said William B.
 Whitehead for himself his Executors and administrators covenants with the other party
 to these presents that he will faithfully execute the trust hereby reposed in him
 and apply the proceeds of such sales and Collection according to the true intent &
 meaning of this deed and whatever balance of money arising from the said sales
 and Collection shall remain after satisfying and paying the debts due to the
 Creditors of the said Gilbert H. Beale shall be restored to him the said Gilbert H.
 Beale or his proper representative In Witness whereof the said Gilbert H.
 Beale and William B. Whitehead have hereunto set their hands and affixed
 their seals this day and year before written
