Robert Evans Richard Pyleman and Patrick Pond's land a said line from hence
bearing NNE at the corner of Patrick Pond's fence, then a straight line of marked
trees to the road above mentioned thence up the road to the first station house belonging on
any land appertaining with the reservation and reservations remainders and remaining
spes and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said
Bargain and promises with the appurtenances unto the Said Henry Denner his heirs and
assigns forever and the Said Walter G. Brattle and Polly his wife for themselves their
heirs Executors and administrators the said Bargain and promises and every part unpaired
thereof, with all their appurtenances clear simple and freed from all claims whether
in Covenants, debts or otherwise unto the Said Henry Denner his heirs and assigns against
all and every person or persons whatsoever, does shall and will by these presents give
