The Condition of the above obligation is such that Whereas the above named David D. Savage hath been duly appointed Constable of the County of Southampton by the Court of said County to supply the vacancy created by the resignation of Thomas C. Jones now if the said David D. Savage shall ever and truly discharge the duties of the Office of Constable in the said County during his continuance therein then the above obligation to be void, or else to remain in full force and virtue.
