Savage hath been duly appointed Constable of the County of Southampton by the Court of said County to supply the vacancy created by the resignation of Thomas C. Jones et al of the said David D. Savage shall well and truly discharge the duties of the Office of Constable in the said County during his continuance thereon the above obligation to be used, or else to remain in full force and virtue.
