This Indenture made and entered into this the 17 day of July 1832 Between Orri
 A. Brown of the first part & William R. Edwards of the second part and Jesse Sanford of the third
 part and all of the County of Southampton. It is testified that whereas the said Orris A. Brown
 stands jointly indebted unto the said Jesse Sanford with the just sum of fifteen hundred dol-
 lars for his own use and to wit the said Jesse Sanford and payable on demand and that the said
 Orris A. Brown is desirous to secure and have agreed to secure the payment of the said
 debt with the interest that may thereon lawfully accrue with all charges all owing the
 same, or incurred by reason of the premises, by conveying the property herein after mentioned
 unto the said William R. Edwards and to be sold for that purpose, it was therefore
 this Indenture further Well to effect that the said Orris A. Brown in consideration
 of the premises and of the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to him by the
 said W. R. Edwards in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged that
 bargained and sold conveyed and made over and do by these presents bargain and sell
 confirm and make over unto him the said William R. Edwards by his heirs executors and
 assigns the following property to wit, The tract of land whereon the said Orris A.
 Brown now resides containing five hundred acres more or less being the same land
 which the said Brown purchased of Thomas R. Gray by deed admitted to Record
 in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County on the 24 day of March 1830 for the Com-
 mittee of the said Land Reformers made to the said deed also the following slaves
 to wit Peter, Jesse, Shamus, and Paddy To have and to hold the said Estate
 and property above mentioned unto him the said William R. Edwards by his heirs executors
 administrators and assigns in full and upon consideration made of the fact that if the said
 Orris A. Brown shall fail to pay the whole of the aforesaid debt with the legal interest
 thereon to the said Jesse Sanford his Executors, Administrators or assigns either demanded
