Stuart of the same County and Parish of the other part. Witness that the said Matthew Williams for and in consideration of the sum of forty dollars to him in hand paid by the said John P. Stuart the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged himsself fully and completely paid and paid such granted bargain sold and confirmed and by these presents hath granted bargain sold and conveyed unto the said John P. Stuart one certain tract or parcel of land and premises situate & lying on the right in the County of Southampton containing by a former survey fifty two acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit a corner there is a line of marked trees between James Raper and the said land thence at corner in the west branch of the stream down the middle of the said branch to the fork thence up the stream Jesse Brooks and the said land to the first station together with all the houses out houses buildings yards gardens orchard ways and water ways &c that now belong in anywise appertaining To have and to hold the said land to him the said John P. Stuart to him and to his heirs forever and the Matthew Williams for his heirs and assigns doth warrant and defend by these presents any person or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part thereof. Witness that the said John James for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars lawful money of the revenue of the State to him by the said Aaron James in hand paid the receipt whereof the said John James doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargain sold and conveyed unto the said Aaron James his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing five hundred and fourteen acres be the same more or less lying and being in the County aforesaid and known by the name of Long's tract it being the same over which Aaron James and his heirs formerly lived on one side and by the lands of Charles F. Waples and Samuel James & Elizabeth Drake. To have and to hold the said tract of land and the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said Aaron James his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of
