other part. Witnesseth that the said John James as will be found in Consideration of Natural  
love and affection which he has and bears towards his aforesaid Children to wit Richard  
H & Mary T James as of five dollars lawful money of the United States to him in  
hand paid by the said Richard H James and Mary T James at or before the making  
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and acknowl-  
edged and is sold and confirmed and by these presents doth give and sell unto and confirm unto  
the said Richard H James and Mary T James their heirs and assigns forever all eight  
tenth parts claim or demand either in reversion or remainder to be held to the said John  
James is entitled to or may be entitled to at the death of his mother Ann James with  
down Estate of the said Ann James held by her as Trustee as of her or of her deceased husband  
John James or of the estate of the said Ann in her own right which the said John  
James might have taken as distributive of his mother Ann James the aforesaid estate  
either in remainder or reversion by descent devise or otherwise which might come to the  
proportion of the said John James unto the said Richard H and Mary T James  
for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid unto the said Richard H and Mary  
T James their heirs and assigns against the claim or claims of the said John James
