This Indenture made and entered into this 20th of March 1833, between Orvis & Brown of the first part Stephen M'Nerrough of the second part and James M'Nerrough of the third part whereas the said Orvis & Brown is fully indebted to the said James M'Nerrough in the sum of two hundred dollars with interest on one thousand dollars from this day to be paid on the 25th day of December next, as by a Bond bearing equal date with these presents more fully appears for this Indenture witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the promises as also for the further Consideration of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the said Orvis & Brown on hand paid by the said Stephen M'Nerrough at and before the delivery and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Orvis & Brown has given granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released and confirmed by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release and confirm to the said Stephen M'Nerrough all that tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton in the state of Virginia containing five hundred acres to be the same more or less being the land on which the said Orvis now resides and to which he belongs of Thomas Gray as will more fully appear by Returns to the Auditor of the said Gray to the said Orvis man of Record in the Clerks Office in the County of said land with all and singular the appurtenances to the said tract or parcel of Land belonging or in anywise abutting thereon to have and to hold the said hereby granted or intended to be hereby granted tract or parcel of Land and promises with the appurtenances unto the said Stephen M'Nerrough his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever and the said Orvis & Brown for himself his heirs Executors administrators doth hereby covenant promise and agree to and with the said Stephen M'Nerrough his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever in manner and form following that is to say the said Orvis & Brown his heirs &c shall after and tract of Land and promises with all appurtenances unto the said Stephen M'Nerrough his heirs & against all persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and for ever defend by these presents upon Trust Novice set that the said Stephen M'Nerrough his heirs &c shall permit the said Orvis & Brown to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the said tract of Land U^t and take the profit thereof to his own use until default be made in the payment of the said sum either in whole or in part and then upon the further trust that upon the default aforesaid and he shall be required to do he shall adjoin to the said tract of Land for twenty days at some public place in the County aforesaid and then expose the same to public auction for ready money and after paying the expenses of this trust pay the debt aforesaid and if any balance remain pay the same to the said
