This Indenture made and entered into this 11th day of August 1832 Between Bernard J. Griffin and Lucy Griffin his wife of Barrington N. H. of the one part and Carr Bowers Sheriff of the County of Southampton of the other part. Whereas the said Bernard J. Griffin and Lucy Griffin are in custody of the Sheriff of Southampton County by virtue of an execution issued out of the Clerks Office of the County South of Southampton at the suit of Martha Crompton P. C. for John Moulton and being infants and desirous to discharge themselves from custody by conveying all the estate which they inherited by the death of their father Bernard J. Griffin dec. that is to say their interest in two tracts of Land in the County of Southampton of which their deceased father Bernard J. Griffin died seized and possessed containing in the whole three hundred and fifty seven acres more or less and the said Bernard J. and Lucy Griffin in order to discharge themselves from the custody of the Sheriff are required to surrender the same to the aforesaid Sheriff conveying their interest in the aforesaid two tracts of Land and for therefore this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Bernard J. Griffin died seized and possessed To have and to hold the same unto him the said Carr Bowers Sheriff as aforesaid his heirs and assigns forever And the said Bernard J. and Lucy Griffin do hereby warrant and defend the premises lawfully conveyed and intended to be conveyed unto him the said Carr Bowers Sheriff as aforesaid against whom they shall not again in any form or person return ever.
