This Indenture made and entered into this 28th day of August. A.D. 1832 Between
Lutiles R. Edwards of the first part, Joseph Lantford of the second part and Coris A. Brown of the
third part. Whereas the said Coris A. Brown by his deed bearing date the day of July
last admitted to Record on the same day in Order to secure the payment of the sum of fifteen
hundred dollars owing to the said Lantford from the said Brown, conveyed in Trust to the said
Edwards a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton Con-
taining five hundred acres more or less also the following Slaves to wit, Peter Joseph, Sham-
Lucy and Tuckey and the said sum of fifteen hundred dollars having been fully paid by
the said Coris A. Brown to the said Joseph Lantford the said Coris A. Brown hath
requested that the Estate coming by the said Deed of Trust to the said Edwards in hand paid
and that he is also said to be released to him the said Brown. This Indenture therefore
testifies that for and in consideration of the premises and also for and in consideration
of the sum of One dollar by the said Coris A. Brown to the said Edwards in hand paid
before the signing and delivery of these presents the receipt hereof is hereby acknowledged
by the said Lutiles R. Edwards with the consent of the said Joseph Lantford and agreed
by him being a party to and signing these presents, have remitted released and forever quit
claim and by these presents do fully and absolutely Comend release and forever quit claim unto
the said Coris A. Brown his heirs and assigns forever all the estate right title interest person
claim and demand whatsoever in Law or Equity, of them the said Lutiles R. Edwards
him and to the aforesaid Tract of Land and premises with its appurtenances and to
the said Slaves Peter Joseph, Sham Lucy and Tuckey. It have and to be to the aforesaid
said Tract or parcel of Land with its appurtenances and also the aforesaid Slaves Peter
Joseph, Sham Lucy and Tuckey to the said Coris A. Brown his heirs and assigns to the only
benefit use and behoof of the said Coris A. Brown his heirs and assigns forever, so that the said
Lutiles R. Edwards nor his heirs nor any other person whatsoever, claiming under him shall
by any ways or means hereafter have claim challenge or demand, any estate, right title or interest
of or to the said premises and property or any part or parcel thereof, but from all and every
action for the recovery thereof and from all and every estate, right, title, interest or demand
of or to the said premises or any part thereof they and every of them shall be utterly
excluded and barred forever by these presents. In Witness whereof the said Lutiles
R. Edwards and Joseph Lantford have hereunto set their hands and affixed their Seals this
day and date first before written
