3rd Indenture made and Entertained this 28th day of August A.D. 1833 Between
 Littleton R. Edwards of the first part Esq; and John Lankford of the second part and Orris & Brown of the
 third part. Whereas the said Orris & Brown by his Deed bearing date the day of July
 1832 and admitted to Record on the same day in Order to secure the payment of the sum of fifteen
 hundred dollars owing to the said Lankford from the said Brown, conveyed in trust to the said
 Edwards a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton Con-
 taining five hundred acres more or less also the following Slaves to wit Peter Jeph, Icham
 Lucy and Suckey and the said sum of fifteen hundred dollars having been fully paid by
 the said Orris & Brown to the said John Lankford his the said Orris & Brown which
 requested that the Estate conveyed by the said Deed of Trust to the said Edwards with land
 and other to be released to him the said Brown. This Indenture therefore
 witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the premises and also for and in Consideration
 of the sum of One dollar by the said Orris & Brown to the said Edwards in hand paid
 before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 to the said Littleton R. Edwards with the consent of the said John Lankford signified
 by his being a party to and signing these presents have received released and for ever quit claim unto
 the said Orris & Brown his heirs and assigns forever all the estate right title interest property
 claim and demand whatsoever in Law or Equity, of them the said Littleton R. Edwards
 of and to the aforesaid tract of Land and premises with its appurtenances and to
 the said Slaves Peter, Jeph, Icham Lucy and Suckey To have and to hold the aforesaid
 said tract or parcel of Land with its appurtenances and also the aforesaid Slaves Peter,
 Jeph, Icham Lucy and Suckey to the said Orris & Brown his heirs and assigns to the only
 survivor and heirs of the said Orris & Brown his heirs and assigns forever so that the said
 Littleton R. Edwards nor his heirs nor any other person who may own, claiming under him shall
 by any ways or means hereafter have, claim challenge or demand, any estate, right title or interest
 of or to the said premises and property or any part or parcel thereof, but from all and every
 action for the recovery thereof and from all and every estate, right, title, interest or demand
 of or to the said premises or any part thereof they and every of them shall be wholly
 excluded and banished forever by these presents. In Witness whereof the said Littleton
 R. Edwards and John Lankford have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this
 day and year first before written.
