 of the Accomack Swamp the tract or parcel of Land whereof Joshua Hines said seized and
 possessed to have and to hold the said tract and parcel of Land and every part and parcel thereof
 so long as the said Miles Scarborough and Delilah his wife and Richard Hines and Elizabeth
 wife and John Hines and Martha his wife are interested in the same and the said Miles
 Scarborough and wife and Richard and John Hines and their heirs for themselves their heirs
 assigns issue forever maintain and defend the right and title of and in the said tract and parcel of Land unto the
 said Edmund Halcome his heirs and assigns so far as they have thereby conveyed or so far as they are
 interested in the said Land against themselves their heirs and assigns and against all persons
